Award: Scholarships will be awarded to applicants for the 2026-2027 school year.

Application Deadline: July 1, 2026

Category 1- 2 awards of \$5,000 each

Category 2- 2 awards of \$2,500 each

Category 3- 2 awards of \$1,000 each

Eligibility Requirements

- Currently a graduating high school senior or a post-secondary student - High school or post-secondary grade point average of 3.0 or above
- Citizen or permanent resident of the United States
- **Category 1**
 - Pending acceptance or enrolled in a post-secondary education program for
 - Paramedic Emergency Medicine or
 - Fire Protection or Fire Science or
 - Emergency Management or
 - Healthcare
 - Shall be a Legal dependent of an active member of the New Hampshire Association of Fire Chiefs
- **Category 2**
 - Pending acceptance or enrolled in a post-secondary education program for other related fields as determined by the Scholarship Committee
 - Shall be a Legal dependent of an active member of the New Hampshire Association of Fire Chiefs
- **Category 3**
 - Pending acceptance or enrolled in a New Hampshire post-secondary education program for:
 - Paramedic Emergency Medicine or
 - Fire Protection or Fire Science or
 - Emergency Management or
 - Healthcare
 - Shall be a member of Fire Department whose Chief Officer is an active member of the New Hampshire Association of Fire Chiefs
- **ALL APPLICANTS**
- Agreement to attend a NHAFC meeting to accept your award
- Scholars should be willing to update the NHAFC about their experience by April 2027
- Scholars must use the funds awarded within one calendar year from the official award date

NOTE: Applicants can reapply annually. Scholarship Awards contingent on funding and Board approval.
